Turnout to be judged 70% on the condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle, neatness and appropriateness of attire and overall impression, 30% on performance, manners and way of going. Working class to be judged 70% on performance, manners and way of going; 20% on condition and fit of harness and vehicle; 10% on neatness of attire.

To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style and 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes to be judged 100% on performance. Animals not exceeding 13.2 hands shall jump 2'0"; animals exceeding 13.2 hands shall jump 2'6"

Under Saddle Classes: To be eligible, pony must have shown in and completed an over fences class. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. A maximum of eight animals may be asked to gallop one way of the ring. To be judged 75% on performance, manners and style, and 25% on breed type and conformation.

SHORT STIRRUP CLASSES

Open to registered ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Open to Riders 12 and under not competing in any other Over Fences classes. (this includes the flat class)

Over Fences: To be shown over a course of a minimum of four 18" fences with eight jumping efforts. Animals may either trot or canter the entire course. To be judged 100% on performance. Under Saddle: To be eligible, pony must be entered and complete a course in at least one over fence (o/f) class. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged 100% on performance.

Open to ponies/cobs/Half-Welsh. To be judged 100% on the riders appearance, seat, hands, and control of their mount.

Over fences: To be shown over a minimum of six obstacles. 2'0" for Small/Medium Ponies, 2'6" for Large Ponies and Horses

Under Saddle: to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Tests may be required.

Section A, B, C or Half-Welsh, mare or gelding, 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than eight, years of age. Ponies to be judged on manners, suitability, breed type, conformation and turnout. This is not an equitation class.

263 WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY (Article 115.2)

Section A, B, C and Half-Welsh, mare or gelding 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than 10, years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. Ponies to be shown at a walk and trot or jog, both ways of the ring. Ponies to be judged on performance, manners and suitability. Conformation, way of going, and turnout to be emphasized. This is not an equitation class.

264 WPCSA WALK-TROT (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except, leading rein and child's first pony

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All Welsh ponies six years & over, showing in breeding classes and all Welsh and half Welsh ponies showing in WPCSA performance classes must be measured or present a valid USEF or WPCSA measurement card All ponies and cobs must show current membership cards or be measured at the show.
2. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless noted.
3. The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and to combine or cancel classes with fewer than three entries. However, WPCSA Rules State that classes/divisions cannot be added or combined once the prize list has been mailed.
4. All Welsh animals must be registered in the stud books of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America, Inc., or the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Canada and must be entered under their full registered name, or if under one year, be eligible for registration.
5. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.
6. Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Please Note All Ponies Must Be Registered

All ponies (both Welsh and Half Welsh must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, or Canada, or in the case of foals, be eligible for registration, in order to be eligible for any recognized class or division of this show.
